Please carefully read the following information in its entirety to help us provide the best possible experience for you and your student.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

LUGGAGE TAG:

This packet includes a luggage tag for your student's one checked bag (which will be stored under the bus); in addition, students may bring one smaller carry-on bag onto the bus.

Please write your student's full name, phone number, campus and bus number on the tag and attach it to the top handle of the luggage.

- You will receive an email a week before camp with your student's bus number
- If you don't attend one of our physical campus locations, write "online" as the campus

WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM:

The waiver and release form is mandatory for each student participating in Student Camp. Please fill out this form as soon as possible. Students will not be able to get on the bus if this form isn't submitted. Please scan this QR code to complete the Shocco High School waiver.



PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF EXCEPTIONS:

If your student is getting dropped off or picked up by someone who is not their parent or guardian, please notify studentcamp@coe22.com with the student's full name and the full name of the adult picking them up (a driver's license or government ID will be required for pick-up).

THE RIVALRY:

The Rivalry is an exciting part of Student Camp! This packet contains a card that reveals the squad your student will compete with throughout the week of camp.

The Rivalry is a week-long team competition that gives students the opportunity to build community, have fun and work together throughout the week. Each student has been assigned a squad and will earn points based on their swag, energy and victories. As camp approaches, we encourage students to prepare their squad swag and come ready to participate, compete and support their team!

ONCE YOU ARRIVE

ARRIVAL TIMES AND LOCATIONS:

We will have two check-in locations for students. It is extremely important that you drop your student off at the correct location. Campuses will begin arriving during their designated drop-off times on July 27. Please ensure your student is dropped off on time and at the correct campus.

St. Johns Campus Check-In Location: *Fleming Island, Mandarin, Orange Park, Palatka, St. Augustine and St. Johns*

7:00am: Mandarin, Orange Park, Palatka

7:30am: Fleming Island and St. Augustine

BAGGAGE DROP-OFF:

We ask that you drop your luggage at the buses before entering the building and checking in. Upon entering the parking lot, our parking team will direct you to the buses, where you can drop off your tagged luggage before entering the building.

FINALIZE CHECK-IN:

After tagged luggage has been dropped off at the buses, students and parents can park and enter through the San Pablo/St. Johns front doors to finalize check-in. This step is extremely important, as we want to ensure that each student has a signed waiver, any required medication turned in and payment finalized.

OVERNIGHT PARKING:

We are asking that all students be dropped off by a parent and NOT drive themselves, leaving their car overnight.

MEDICATION:

Our medical team is equipped to securely store and oversee all medication at Student Camp. All prescription and daily medication must be checked in with the medical team during the check-in process — look for our medical team with signage when you arrive. You will have the opportunity to specify dosage and administration times. Students will self-administer their medication under the supervision of our trained medical staff. Please ensure all medications are listed on the medical waiver completed for your student prior to camp.
